

### Grammaire: l'Objet Direct

The direct object refers to the noun that receives the action of a verb. You can identify it by asking yourself who or what receives the action. It can be replaced by a direct object pronoun to avoid repetition. In French, the direct object pronoun precedes the verb.

#### Example:

I watch the movie. Je regarde le film.      I watch it. Je le regarde.

	Singular	plural
1st person	me / m' me	nous us
2nd person	te / t' you	vous you
3rd person	le / l' him, it la / l' her, it	les them
