The verb avoir is used impersonally in the expression il y a (there is, there are).

Il y a un salon dans l'appartement. There is a living room in the apartment.

Il y a trois lampes dans la chambre. There are three lamps in the room.

Il n'y a pas de frigo dans la cuisine. There isn't a fridge in the kitchen.
