

**Grammaire: Adjectifs Démonstratifs**

A demonstrative adjective points out to a specific person or thing: this book, that teacher, these pictures, those paintings.

The French demonstrative adjective has four forms. The form agrees with the noun it modifies.

	Masculine	Feminine
SINGULAR	ce/cet	cette
PLURAL	ces	ces

The French demonstrative adjective by itself does not distinguish between this and that or these and those. If you want to stress one or the other, you can add the suffixes –ci (here) or –là (there).

**Example:**

Do you like this dress or that dress?  
Tu aimes cette robe-ci ou cette robe-là?
